MANDATORY QUALIFICATIONS

POST GRADUATE TEACHERS

- (i) A Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate:-
- (aa) PGT (English): English
- (ab) PGT (Hindi): Hindi
- (ac) PGT (Maths): Mathematics/ Applied Mathematics
- (ad) PGT (Physics): Physics/ Electronics/ Applied Physics/ Nuclear Physics
- (ae) PGT (Chemistry) : Chemistry/ Bio-Chemistry
- (af) PGT (Biology): Botany/ Zoology/ Life Sciences/ Bio-Sciences/ Genetics/ Micro-Biology/Bio-Technology/ Molecular Biology/Plant Physiology, provided the candidate has studied Botany and Zoology at graduation level
- (ag) PGT (History) : History
- (ah) PGT (Geography): Geography
- (aj) PGT (Commerce): Commerce with Accountancy/ Cost Accounting/ Financial Accountancy. Holder of degree of M Com in Applied/ Business Economics shall not be eligible
- (ak) PGT (Economics) : Economics/ Applied Economics/ Business Economics
- (al) PGT (Computers): B.E. or B.Tech (Computer Science/IT) or an equivalent Degree or Diploma from an institution/university recognised by the Govt. of India. OR
- B.E or B.Tech (any stream) and Post Graduate Diploma in Computers from any recognised University

OR

M.Sc. (Computer Science)/ MCA or equivalent from a recognised University OR

B.Sc. (Computer Science)/ BCA or equivalent and Post Graduate degree in any subject from a recognised University

OR

Post Graduate Diploma in Computer and Post Graduate degree in any subject from a recognised University

OR 'A' Level from DOEACC and Post Graduate degree in any subject OR

'B' or 'C' Level from DOEACC

- (ii) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education. However, B.Ed. degree is not mandatory for the post of PGT (Computers)
- (iii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

- (iv) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (v) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (vi) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School will be given age relaxation up to the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.
- (vii) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except PGT Hindi).

TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS

- (i) A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate, including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects as under:-
- (aa) TGT (Maths): Maths with any two out of Physics, Chemistry, Electronics, ComputerScience or Statistics
- (ab) TGT (Science): Botany, Zoology and Chemistry (All three subjects should have been studied) recognised institution Regional Colleges of Education
- (ii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (iii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (iv) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (v) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.
- (vi) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except TGT Hindi, Sanskrit, Games and Drawing).
- (b) Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection)

- (i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- (ii) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.
- (iii) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weight age during selection.

PRIMARY TEACHERS

- (i) A Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/AICTE, with minimum marks of 50 percent in the aggregate.
- (ii) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.
- (iii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (iv) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (v) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (vi) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.
- (vii) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

NURSERY TRAINED TEACHER

- (i) Senior Secondary with Nursery Teachers Training diploma or diploma in Nursery/Montessori/Pre-Primary Teachers Training or Diploma in Elementary Education from a Govt recognised institution. While candidates with higher qualifications may apply, preference is to be given to candidates with diploma in Nursery/Montessori Training.
- (ii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (iii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (iv) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of

continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

- (v) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT/PRT/ or three years as NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.
- (vi) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

HELPERS

(a) Only the following categories of Helpers (erstwhile Multi-Tasking Staff) are to be employed as per the scale authorized as per Para 7(d), Chapter 4. Henceforth, only

the following trade categories of Helpers are permitted:-

- (i) Ayah
- (ii) Peon
- (iii) Gardener
- (iv) Sweeper
- (b) No educational qualifications are laid down. However, candidates should be selected keeping in view suitability for trade duties.
- (c) Should be in the age group of 21 to 40 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (d) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (e) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuousservice in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (f) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years.
- (g) BOO must satisfy itself about the genuineness of the date of birth of the candidates.
